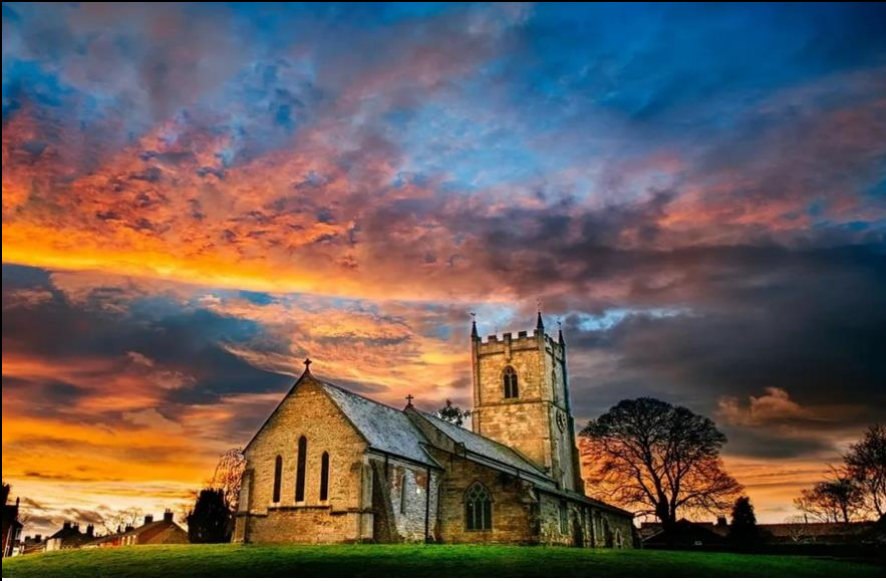

## Barrow Upon Humber – A Brief History

Barrow upon Humber is a thriving village of around 3000 people situated about a mile from the river Humber and three miles from the Humber Bridge and is surrounded by the scenic landscape of the Humber estuary, providing opportunities for outdoor activities, and enjoying nature.

The village has a long history, with evidence of human habitation dating back to Roman times. The area has seen various settlements and developments over the centuries. The proximity to the Humber estuary also means that water transportation has played a role in the area's history.

Barrow upon Humber is home to Holy Trinity Church, a Grade I listed building with a history dating back to the Norman era. As a result, the church is of both architectural and historical significance.

The Parish Council was formed in 1894 and today there are 12 councillors serving the village and nearby Barrow Haven.

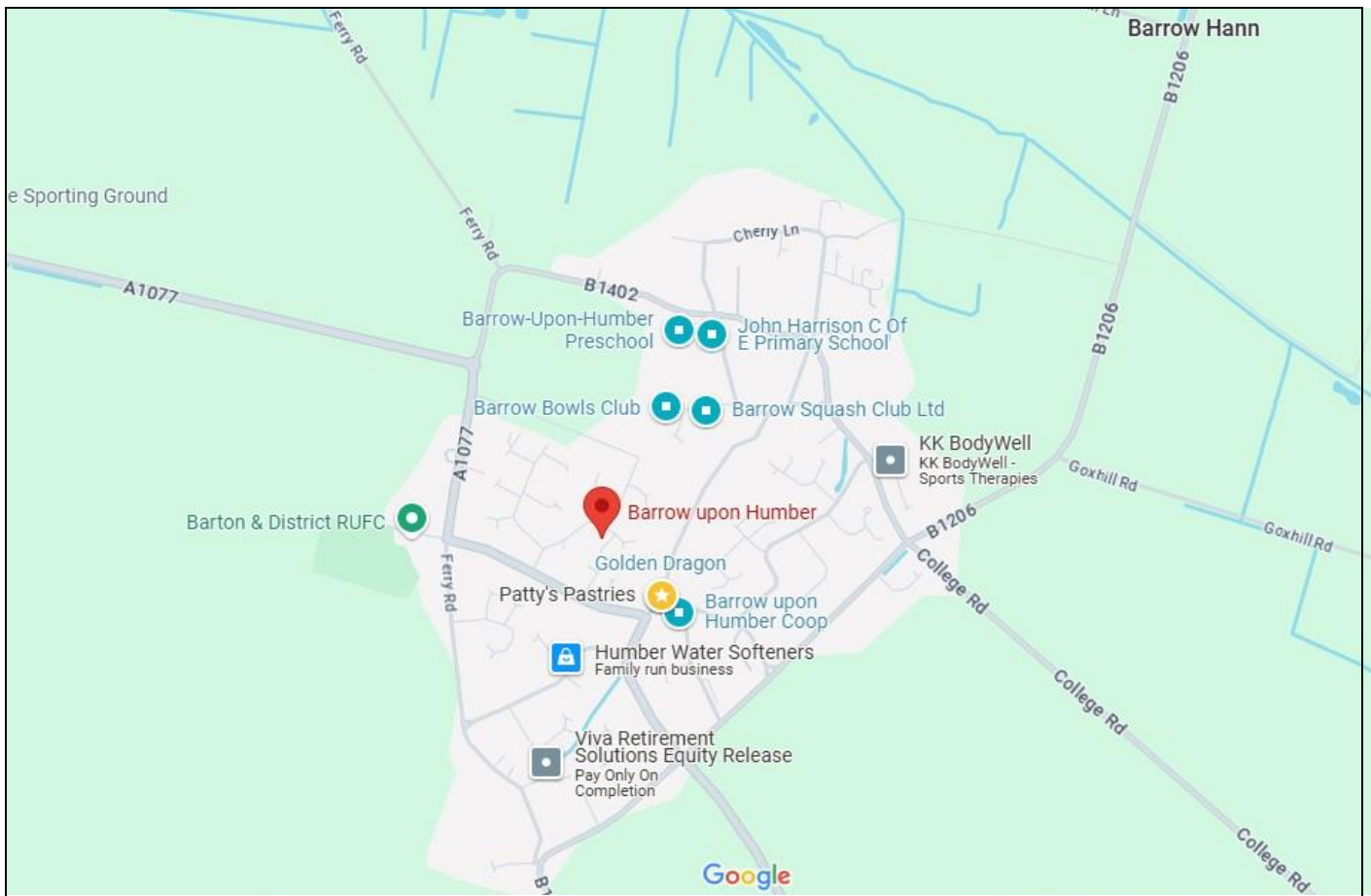
